THE COPPER CLUB MARKS 75 YEARS OF CELEBRATION AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Since its inception in 1944 to celebrate the industry's contribution to the World War II effort, the Copper Club has maintained a leadership role within the industry. In 1962, the Copper Club established the prestigious Ankh Award to honor those who demonstrated exceptional leadership within their companies and significant contributions to the industry. In 1994, the Copper Club introduced the Educational Grants Program, which assists exceptional students in preparation for careers in fields related to the copper industry. Each grant is awarded to students who demonstrate academic excellence and financial need. To date, The Copper Club has provided more than \$1.2 million in scholarships to students to help ensure the future of copper.

"We are thrilled to celebrate this major milestone in our history with those who support our mission to honor those who have forged pathways in the industry and to pave new paths for students working toward future in it," said Copper Club Chairman, **Arthur R.
