### **About Oriol Guixà**

Oriol Guixà (Barcelona, 1952), an Industrial and Aeronautical Engineer with more than 45 years of experience in the copper industry, is widely recognized as one of the foremost advocates and promoters of this metal, its exceptional properties, and its remarkable potential.

He is the majority shareholder and Chairman of the Board of La Farga, a company with more than 218 years of industrial heritage. When he joined the company in the early 1980s, La Farga processed barely 4,000 tons of copper per year and was on the brink of collapse. Under Oriol Guixà's leadership, it has been transformed into a global industrial group with revenues exceeding USD 2.4 billion and has become an internationally recognized benchmark in copper recycling technology and sustainable solutions, with production facilities in Spain and the United States.

At just 28 years old, he led La Farga out of bankruptcy by making a decisive commitment to innovation, talent and technological excellence, placing recycling at the core of the company's strategy. Long before sustainability became a priority in our society, he championed the unique properties of copper and its long-term value for industry and society. His technical curiosity, combined with a disruptive, visionary and resilient mindset, has driven continuous progress through proprietary know-how and patented industrial processes. These innovations have embedded the principles of the circular economy at the heart of industrial activity, enabling major advances in energy efficiency, responsible resource usage and the direct transformation of copper scrap into high-quality finished products through advanced pyrometallurgical refining processes.

A firm believer in industry as a cornerstone of societal progress and wealth creation, his commitment to society and the environment—together with his conviction that collaboration is a key driver of transformation—has made him a leading voice within the global copper sector. He plays an active role in major international industry and civic organizations, including the European Copper Institute, the International Wrought Copper Council, the London Metal Exchange and various Chambers of Commerce.

A true enthusiast for copper and its properties, he founded Europe's first Copper Museum as a tribute to the pivotal role this metal has played in the development of civilization. Through the La Farga Foundation, he also actively promotes education, research and innovation among younger generations.

Married and the father of five, Oriol Guixà is widely recognized as a visionary and inspiring leader, convinced that leadership is, above all, a commitment to people, to society and to the generations yet to come.
